GENESIS IS BOTH HISTORIC AND PROPHETIC

Today's teaching is not just about Noah. I will show you that Genesis is the most prophetic book in the Bible. It is also the history of YHVH creating a people and a Kingdom.

Genesis is the most prophetic book in the Bible but its prophecies are obscure, they give only allusions to future events and scant details. One must read the scripture with an eye toward both history and prophecy. History is prophecy.

Genesis is the history of Israel, YHVH calling out a people from the world, the cosmos spoken of in John 3:16, for His name's sake.

Reveals His Kingdom on earth

Begins with YHVH's government structure

Heavenly High Priest and King who has a righteous earthly counterpart called Melchizedek – my King of righteousness - who presides over the people of the earth, and whose job is to call people to repentance.

Prophesies about the coming and fall of the nation of Israel, its troubles, and the world's, and that the Messiah will come through YHVH's own nation of Israel.

Prophesies about the end times

First KOTN, which is prophesied in greater detail in Daniel 11, appears in Genesis 14. The KOTN a coalition of Kings that invade Jordan. Today, the ancient Persian people, Iran, is in coalition with 4 Middle Eastern nations just like the Genesis 14 coalition which was led by King Amraphel some historians say may have been Nimrod himself.

Abram typifies Yeshua rescuing, in the end of days, His people from the clutches of the end times KOTN in the episode of Lot's captivity.

The Noah Torah Portion hints that the earth will be destroyed another way besides water in the end. Starting with Sodom and Gomorrah, we begin to see the pattern of destruction by fire. Why must the earth be destroyed by fire? I will explain that in a little bit.

The coming Kingdom is prophesied in Genesis 1. What was God doing in Genesis 1?

KINGDOM PROPHECY

Joh 14:2 In my Father's house are many homes [mansions, G3438 mone, residences]. If it weren't so, I would have told you. I am going to prepare a place for you.

Joh 14:3 If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and will receive you to myself; that where I am, you may be there also.

The place that is prepared for Yeshua YHVH's Kingdom is the earth with His people inhabiting the land of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob's inheritance, with Jerusalem as its capital and the capital of the earth.

But you have to read to the end of the book, to Revelation 21 and 22, to understand is what is happening in Genesis 1.

Genesis 2 is about the creation of a Melchizedek priesthood which will work on earth to progress and advance the Kingdom of YHVH on earth.

Adam failed.

PROPHECY OF MESSIAH

In Adam's failure comes a need for a savior who can redeem the situation and populate His Kingdom.

Gen 3:14 Yahweh God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this, you are cursed above all livestock, and above every animal of the field. You shall go on your belly and you shall eat dust all the days of your life.

Gen 3:15 I will put hostility between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring. He will bruise your head, and you will bruise his heel."

Aaron's failure at the golden calf tells us from where the Messiah will come.

The Messiah of the cosmos cannot come from just any people group. He must come from a specific people group which is Israel.

THE NAME, NOACH

Noach:

Name meaning: H5117 and H5118 means "rest", "settle down" and "comfort".

Noah was the 8th Melchizedek

8 is the number which begins the next cycle

Prophetically, that cycle will start after the next Millennium, the 7th Millennium, is completed. We still have to get through that one before the 8th one comes.

NOAH'S TIME POINTS TO THE SAME PROBLEMS IN OUR TIME

Gen 6:11 The earth was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence.

Mat 24:37 "As the days of Noah were, so will be the coming of the Son of Man.

Mat 24:38 For as in those days which were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered into the ship,

Mat 24:39 and they didn't know until the flood came, and took them all away, so will be the coming of the Son of Man.

Gen 6:12 God saw the earth, and saw that it was corrupt, for all flesh had corrupted their way on the earth.

The corruption of the earth was violence:

The people had learned to live with the violence, they had not stopped it but had allowed it to continue, and they were just going on with their lives as if the violence did not exist or would not affect them.

Apathy: "As long as I am not affected, I don't care what the situation does to others".

In Noah's time, all the people of the earth were YHVH's because of the work of the Melchizedeks. There was no differentiation between people - Hebrews and Gentiles are a later development in Genesis 14:13. The only differentiation at this time was between righteous Noah and his family and the remaining corrupt population.

Some of that population were Nephilim – half human, half demon. The advent of the mRNA vaccines is the modern technological repeat of this corruption of the flesh. People have been already corrupt in the spirit, which corruption set the stage for the corruption of the flesh. This corruption makes people unredeemable like the Nephilim of Noah's time.

YHVH has a way of dealing with corrupt people, the law of which comes almost a thousand years after Noah:

Numbers 5:11-31 – bitter waters test. The flood was humanity's bitter waters test.

Only Noah passed the test of faithfulness and his family was saved alive because of it.

Prophesies of and fulfills the promise of Deuteronomy 30:1-6.

YHVH saves His people and their children.

Noah is our first example of this promise to save the children of the faithful.

NOAH AND THE LAW OF YHVH

Did Noah know the Law, the Torah? Yes.

YHVH commanded 2 of every living creature:

Gen 6:19 Of every living thing of all flesh, you shall bring two of every sort into the ship, to keep them alive with you. They shall be male and female.

Gen 6:20 Of the birds after their kind, of the livestock after their kind, of every creeping thing of the ground after its kind, two of every sort will come to you, to keep them alive.

YHVH commanded 7 pairs – 14 – of every clean animal

Gen 7:2 You shall take seven pairs of every clean animal with you, the male and his female. Of the animals that are not clean, take two, the male and his female.

Gen 7:3 Also of the birds of the sky, seven and seven, male and female, to keep seed alive on the surface of all the earth.

Gen 9:3 Every moving thing that lives will be food for you. As I gave you the green herb, I have given everything to you.

Gen 9:4 But flesh with its life, that is, its blood, you shall not eat.

Compare Acts 15:

Act 15:19 "Therefore my judgment is that we don't trouble those from among the Gentiles who turn to God,

Act 15:20 but that we write to them that they abstain from the pollution of idols, from sexual immorality, from what is strangled, and from blood.

As YHVH used food as Adam and Eve's test of faithfulness in the garden, YHVH will now use food as a test of distinction. He begins by allowing humans to eat all things then requires those who are faithful to eat only the clean creatures as an expression of their faith.

Gen 6:9 These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God.

PERFECT H8549 תמים Tav Mem Yod Mem sofitt tâmîym taw-meem'

From H8552; entire (literally, figuratively or morally); also (as noun) integrity, truth: - without blemish, complete, full, perfect, sincerely (-ity), sound, without spot, undefiled, upright (-ly), whole.

תמם tâmam

tarriarri

taw-mam'

A primitive root; to complete, in a good or a bad sense, literally or figuratively, transitively or intransitively: - accomplish, cease, be clean [pass-] ed, consume, have done, (come to an, make an) end, fail, come to the full, be all gone, X be all here, be (make) perfect, be spent, sum, be (shew self) upright, be wasted, whole.

Tamiym means perfect and tamam means clean.

Tamiym comes from the root word, tamam. These words only differ from each other because tamiym, perfect, has a yod before the mem soffit.

Tav Mem Mem sofitt – tamam, clean – perfect, meaning whole as in entirely obedient

Tav Mem Yod Mem sofitt – tamiym, clean, as in from the list of those practices that help us to remain clean before YHVH

The yod points to Yeshua.

The people in Genesis, Noah and his family, looked forward to the Messiah while we look backward in time to our Messiah Yeshua.

Yes, Noah kept the Law of YHVH.

NOAH, THE 8TH MELCHIZEDEK

How did Noah know to keep the Law of YHVH?

Revisit creation of Order of Melchizedek on earth:

Two creation accounts – people (Genesis 1 before the first Sabbath), then Adam and Eve (after the first Sabbath).

Gen 2:8 Yahweh God planted a garden eastward, in Eden, and there he put the man whom he had formed.

"Eastward" is a direction away from something. If there is no "something", then the direction is simply "east".

What was westward from the garden?

Rev 21:2 I saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared like a bride adorned for her husband.

YHVH's Temple from where He intended to rule the earth. It was from this Temple that His voice walked with Adam to train Adam in righteousness.

What is Melchizedek priesthood?

YHVH's government structure

Heavenly Kingship and priesthood – Yeshua - with an earthly counterpart of righteous human males

How can we know this?

Isa 46:9 Remember the former things of old: for I am God, and there is no other. I am God, and there is none like me.

Isa 46:10 I declare the end from the beginning, and from ancient times things that are not yet done. I say: My counsel will stand, and I will do all that I please.

Rev 21:2 I saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared like a bride adorned for her husband.

Rev 21:3 I heard a loud voice out of heaven saying, "Behold, God's dwelling is with people, and he will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God.

I propose that what will be is what was already. There was a Temple and perhaps a city but at least a Temple and YHVH created the Garden to be "eastward" from that.

Noah was the 8th preacher of righteousness.

2Pe 2:5 And [YHVH] spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly;

G1343 dikaiosunē - LXX reference to chesed (mercy), mishpat (law) and tsadik (righteous) to name a few

Noah was the 8th from who? Adam. There are 10 names in the pre-flood genealogy of Genesis 4 – Adam, Seth, Enosh, Kenan, Mahalel, Jared, Enoch, Methuselah, Lamech, Noah.

Each in turn held the office of Melchizedek – my king of righteousness – except for Enoch who was taken and Lamech who died before his father, Methuselah, vacated his office.

Methuselah died the year of the flood and Lamech died 5 years before it.

The office is vacated by death and the designated firstborn son inherits it just as it is done with the Levitical priesthood. Shem was the 9th Melchizedek.

To Noah: Gen 9:11 I will establish my covenant with you: All flesh will not be cut off any more by the waters of the flood. There will never again be a flood to destroy the earth."

The earth will be destroyed by fire the next time. Why?

Lev 21:9 And the daughter of any priest, if she profane herself by playing the whore, she profanes her father: she shall be burnt with fire.

The term "daughter" has a spiritual meaning in that many people groups are called "daughter".

"Daughter of Zion", "daughter of Jerusalem", "daughter of Babylon", "daughter of Tarshish" and "daughter of Zidon". All references to people groups belonging to those cultures.

Hence, all the people of the earth is also "daughter", a people group, that came from Noah. He was the preacher, the Melchizedek, earthly King and Priest to Yeshua who was the Heavenly King and Priest. Japheth, Ham and Shem were the priest's kids and all the people that came from Noah and his sons are priest's kids. As "daughter", the people of the earth who are the priest's kids must now be punished with fire.

CORRECT GENEALOGY

Gen 9:18 The sons of Noah who went out from the ship were Shem, Ham, and Japheth. Ham is the father of Canaan.

This genealogy lists Shem as the oldest but he was, in fact, the youngest.

Chapter 10 list the correct family position of the sons. Japheth was first, Ham was second and Shem was third.

The "firstborn" in YHVH's Kingdom is not necessarily the first out of the womb (although these must always be atoned for). In the ANEC, YHVH and the patriarchs often chose sons who are further down in the lineage to inherit the firstborn position:

Shem - #3 son, 9th Melchizedek (Melchizedek who taught Abram and blessed him in Genesis 14)
Abraham - #3 son

Isaac - #2 son, Promised Son, type of Yeshua Jacob - #2 son Joseph - #11 son Judah - #4 son, Levi - #3 son – they split the position

Don't confuse the office of High Priest of the Order Melchizedek with the firstborn and his inheritance. These are related but not the same. The only exception is Yeshua who is both firstborn and now holds both offices: The office of the heavenly High Priest of the Order of Melchizedek and heavenly King, and, after His resurrection, He also is now the earthly High Priest of the Order of Melchizedek and earthly King.

The first Adam, the first Melchizedek failed. Yeshua, the second Adam, restored the cosmos (John 3:16), the original arrangement of how this earth was supposed to be.

We are still enduring this restoration process. It is a process, a 7,000 year process, to finish creating humans in the likeness of their God, Yeshua, and to complete the restoration of all the heavens and the earth.

Israel was intended to be a Melchizedek nation, a royal (kingly) nation bearing also the authority of priests who would call the nations to repentance to YHVH to restore the damaged cosmos (John 3:16).

Exo 19:5 Now therefore, if you will indeed obey my voice, and keep my covenant, then you shall be my own possession from among all peoples; for all the earth is mine;

Exo 19:6 and you shall be to me a kingdom of priests, and a holy nation.' These are the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel."

Aaron was to be the earthly High Priest of the Order of Melchizedek.

It was the Israelite firstborns who were supposed to serve Aaron.

Golden calf lost Aaron his right to serve as Melchizedek and YHVH took the 3 families of Levi – Gershon, Merari and Kohath - INSTEAD OF the firstborns (Num 3:12, 41 45 and Num 8:16) to serve in the Tabernacle.

Levitical priesthood was a substitute for the Melchizedek priesthood until Yeshua came to restore the Melchizedek priesthood by becoming both its Heavenly and earthly King and High Priest

Aaron's ordination turned out to also be an atonement.

Lev 8:33 You shall not go out from the door of the Tent of Meeting for seven days, until the days of your consecration are fulfilled: for he shall consecrate you seven days.

Lev 8:34 What has been done today, so Yahweh has commanded to do, to make atonement for you.

Yeshua restored the rightful order of Israel as a Kingdom of priests so that non-Israelites can enter in as citizens.

NOACH ADDS DETAIL TO YESHUA'S CRUCIFIXION

Noah's account is another prophesy about YHVH saving His people through the bitter waters trial (Numbers 5). (It will be by fire the next time).

Noah's account reveals the details of Yeshua's crucifixion.

Gen 7:11 In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, on the seventeenth day of the month, on that day all the fountains of the great deep burst open, and the sky's windows opened.

The second month was Cheshvan, the month after Tishrei. (YHVH did not name the months, He numbered them).

His Feast calendar was given to Aaron once it was time for the formal formality of Israel becoming a nation. Our Feast calendar, which includes our weekly Sabbath, sets us apart as different and distinct from the other nations.

Cheshvan became the 8th month on the Feast calendar, another allusion and prophecy about the next cycle of 7.

Gen 7:23 And every living substance was destroyed which was upon the face of the ground, both man, and cattle, and the creeping things, and the fowl of the heaven; and they were destroyed from the earth: and Noah only remained alive, and they that were with him in the ark.

All creatures - man and animals and birds - were destroyed. The fish would have lived because the water is their domain.

Gen 7:24 And the waters prevailed upon the earth an hundred and fifty days.

150 days from Cheshvan 17 brings us to Nissan 17 which brings to the last day that Yeshua was in the grave.

Yeshua died on the 14th of Nissan. 14-15 day 1, 15-16-day2, 16-17-day 3 and then the resurrection.

There were 2 40-day periods. The first was the amount of time it rained.

Gen 7:12 It rained on the earth forty days and forty nights.

Then the ark came to rest on Mount Ararat. This was followed by the second 40-day period.

Gen 8:6 And it came to pass at the end of forty days, that Noah opened the window of the ark which he had made:

Genesis prophesies of both Moses and Yeshua.

Think: Moses pleading on the mountain twice for forty days each time.

Think: Yeshua's 40 days of fasting and testing.

Gen 8:13 And it came to pass in the six hundredth and first year, in the first month, the first day of the month, the waters were dried up from off the earth: and Noah removed the covering of the ark, and looked, and behold, the face of the ground was dry.

Prophecy of the resurrection: This month is Tishrei when Noah saw that the ground was dry. On the 1st day of Tishrei, the day of the trumpet blast AKA the last trump when YHVH's people's resurrection will happen aka Yom Teruah, the month of the fall Feasts.

Gen 8:14 And in the second month, on the seven and twentieth day of the month, was the earth dried.

Noah went into the ark on the 17th of the second month (Cheshvan) and came out 392 days later (365+27=392).

ABRAM PROPHESIES OF YESHUA'S KINGDOM

Abram portrays YHVH calling His people out of Babylon, a theme that will run through the entire scripture to the end of Revelation.

Abram also is our example of believing YHVH Elohim and keeping faith with Him, being faithful through everything even when it seems like no forward progress is happening for 25 years.

Genesis 15 explains how YHVH Elohim, the Father and the Son – our God – will triumph over all of man's, the first Adam's, and the devil's evils.

While Abram watched from a trance state:

Gen 15:17 It came to pass that, when the sun went down, and it was dark, behold, a smoking furnace and a flaming torch passed between these pieces.

The smoking furnace and flaming torch was the Father and the Son.

The sacrificed animals split in half symbolically meant that both parties agreed to be in covenant with Abram's descendants.

If the descendants broke the covenant God had with Abraham, one of them would die.

The Father sent the Son to die because the descendants of Abraham broke the covenant at the golden calf.

THIS is the reason Yeshua had to die.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish, but have eternal life.

The Greek word for "world" is cosmos (John 3:16) and it means "orderly arrangement".

Yeshua died to restore the original order made a creation in Genesis 1. His death restored those who become born of His and the Father's Spirit to the original order and it restored Israel back to its order before the golden calf.

Israel was predestined before the foundation of the world and had to be restored so all non-Israelites could enter as citizens into the Commonwealth of Israel.

The moment the Israelites broke the covenant with YHVH at the base of Mount Sinai with the golden calf, they sealed Yeshua's fate!

JACOB PROPHESIES ABOUT THE TROUBLES OF ISRAEL, THE NATION

Jacob and his 12 sons prophesy of things to come in so many ways that there is not room for that here. Joseph is a type of messiah, Benjamin is a type of those people who, throughout history, have believed YHVH and kept His Law.

Esau is Jacob's, Israel's, perennial enemy. But there are other enemies of Israel from other conflicts. One other conflict comes from the conflict between Shem and Canaan, Ham's son. Another conflict comes from within the family which will be fought in the final battle of Israel's 2900 year old civil war, the Gog-Magog conflict.

There is only room to touch on a few of the prophecies found in Genesis for both Yeshua and the family of Abraham. You have to keep reading to Revelation to get the details of the outcome. The prophecies throughout the scripture after Genesis point back to Genesis in some way.

Even the final King of the North is prophesied in Genesis 14. Specifically, Nimrod and Babylon. He was Abram's enemy and he is our enemy all the way to the end of days. Shem blessed Abraham for defeating Nimrod in chapter 14 and passed the mantle of Melchizedek to Abraham but Abraham died before Shem did. However, Nimrod's spirit is still trying to kill Abram and he is trying to kill Abram's descendants.

Interestingly, the Book of Jasher tells us that Esau beheaded Nimrod. Today, the Edomites are mixed in with the Babylonians but Esau's will to kill Jacob will help him to destroy Babylon (through war) so that he can get at Jacob. This is Armageddon – Esau coming after Jacob. But that is when Yeshua says "enough!".

PATTERNS

Think of Genesis as the start of patterns. If you know the patterns, you will always know what is going to happen next.

BABEL

The Tower of Babel is the beginning of the pattern of people constantly defying, or TRYING to defy, YHVH. Babylon is Satan's empire. Israel is YHVH's empire. Satan's empire IS a beast just as Lucifer, Satan, is a beast ever since his fall. Israel is the best of humanity, the best of YHVH's creation, since those who ARE Israel are they who are born of the Holy Spirit of the Father and the Son.

ABRAM AND SARAI

This couple will now become the focus of Genesis and many prophecies about the Kingdom and the "promised Son". We need to get to know them.

Question: Who was Sarai to Abram?

Gen 11:29 Abram and Nahor married wives. The name of Abram's wife was Sarai, and the name of Nahor's wife was Milcah, the daughter of Haran, who was also the father of Iscah.

Jasher 12: 44 And at that time Nahor and Abram took unto themselves wives, the daughters of their brother Haran; the wife of Nahor was Milca and the name of Abram's wife was Sarai. And Sarai, wife of Abram, was barren; she had no offspring in those days.

In Leviticus 18, sexual relations with the aunt on both the father's and mother's side are prohibited but there is no prohibition against relations between uncle and niece.

This may have been like drinking from a fire hose. The point to take away is that Genesis is both history and prophecy with the prophecies being lived through the lives of the people of that time. What happened back then has continued in cycles and patterns until today. This is why Isaiah tells us that if we want to understand the end, we must first return to and understand the beginning. The end of Revelation will bring us full circle to YHVH's city and His Temple on the earth once again as it was when YHVH planted His garden eastward from it. But before we get to that, we must first endure some very hard times that are coming. It you want to understand what was so you can know what is coming, return to Genesis to find out.
